ORDINANCE NO. 1409

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 16-22; TO PROVIDE PREFERENTIAL RIGHT-OF-WAY AND THE ERECTION OF SIGNS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Section 16-22 of the Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 16-22. <u>Preferential right-of-way; stop</u>
and yield signs. (1) The Council may provide for preferential right-of-way at an intersection and indicate such by stop signs and yield signs erected as designated by the Council.

- (2) Except when directed to proceed by a police officer or traffic control signal, every driver of a vehicle approaching an intersection where a stop is indicated by a stop sign shall stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if there is no such line, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or, if no crosswalk is indicated, then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering the intersection. After having stopped, such driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle which has entered the intersection from another highway or which is approaching so closely on such highway as to constitute an immediate hazard if such driver moved across or into such intersection.
- (3) The driver of a vehicle approaching a yield sign shall slow to a speed reasonable under the existing conditions and, if required for safety to stop, shall stop at a clearly marked stop line, but if there is no such line, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or, if no crosswalk is indicated, then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching

traffic on the intersecting roadway. After slowing or stopping, such driver shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle in the intersection or approaching on another highway so closely as to constitute an immediate hazard if such driver moved across or into such intersection.

Section 2. Section 16-22 as written prior to the passage of this Ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
