## ORDINANCE NO. 1507

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE SOUTH ONE-HALF OF BLOCK NINE (9),

C. L. ERVIN'S SUBDIVISION TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, REPEALING

ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN

PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Whereas, all of the owners of lots and lands thereto have requested the vacation of the south one-half of Block Nine (9), C. L. Ervin's Subdivision to the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the City Council deems it advantageous and best for the interests of the City to vacate the same, now, therefore,

Section 2. The South one-half of Block Nine (9), C. L. Ervin's Subdivision to the City of Lexington, is hereby wholly vacated, excepting, however, any and all public highways, streets, alleys, and public grounds heretofore dedicated to the public which shall be retained in the name of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 3. All of/other sections or parts of sections in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
