ORDINANCE NO. 1509

AN ORDINANCE VACATING LOT ELEVEN (11), BLOCK TWO (2); LOTS ONE(1), TWO (2), THREE (3) and FOUR (4), BLOCK FIVE (5); AND THE NORTH ONE HUNDRED FIFTY FEET (150') OF POLK STREET; OF INDIAN HEIGHTS THIRD ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Whereas, all of the owners of Lots and lands thereto have requested the vacation of Lot Eleven (11), Block Two (2); Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4), Block Five (5); and the North One Hundred Fifty Feet (150') of Polk Street; of Indian Heights Third Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, and the City Council deems it advantageous and best for the interests of the City to vacate the same, now, therefore,

Section 2. Lot Eleven (11), Block Two (2); Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4), Block Five (5); and the North One Hundred Fifty Feet (150') of Polk Street; of Indian Heights Third Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, are hereby wholly vacated, and all the public highways, streets, alleys, avenues, and public grounds therein shall revert to the owners of lots and lands abutting the same in proportion to the respective ownerships of such lots or grounds.

Section 3. All of the sections or parts of sections in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
