ORDINANCE NO. 1511

AN ORDINANCE VACATING SOUTH TAYLOR STREET SOUTH OF THE SOUTH EDGE OF OAK STREET IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


SECTION 1. Whereas, all of the owners of lots joining thereto have requested the vacation of South Taylor Street south of the south edge of Oak Street and the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, deems it advantageous and best for the interest of the City to vacate such street, now, therefore,

SECTION 2. South Taylor Street south of the south edge of Oak Street is hereby wholly and entirely vacated, and shall no longer be or constitute any part of the street system of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the ownership thereof shall revert to the owners of lots adjoining the same in proportion to the respective ownerships of such lots or grounds.

SECTION 3. All of the sections or parts of sections in conflict herewith are repealed.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
