## ORDINANCE NO. 1514-

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE STREET WEST OF SOUTH MADISON STREET

BY AND BETWEEN BLOCK FOUR (4) and FIVE (5), OF JAMES ERWIN'S SECOND SUBDIVISION

TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Whereas, all of the owners of lots adjoining thereto  $\sim$  have requested a vacation of the street west of South Madison Street Lying:

between Block Four (4) and Five (5), of James Erwin's Second Subdivision to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, and the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, deems it advantageous and best for the interest of the City to vacate such street, now therefore,

Section 2. The street running west from South Madison Street to the east edge of South Harrison Street, lying between Block Four (4) and Five (5) of James Erwin's Second Subdivision to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, is hereby wholly and entirely vacated and shall no longer be or constitute any part of the streets of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the ownership thereof shall revert to the owners of the adjacent real estate, one-half (½) upon each side thereof.

Section 3. All of the sections or parts of sections in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
