ORDINANCE NO. 1515

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY BETWEEN SOUTH MADISON STREET AND SOUTH HARRISON STREET IN BLOCK FOUR (4), JAMES ERWIN'S SECOND SUBDIVISION TO THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Whereas, all of the owners of lots and lands thereto have requested the vacation of the alley between South Madison Street and South Harrison Street in Block Four (4) of James Erwin's Second Subdivision to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, and the City Council deems it advantageous and best for the interest of the City to vacate the same, now therefore,

Section 2. The alley running between South Madison Street and South Harrison Street, in Block Four (4), of James Erwin's Second Subdivision to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, is hereby wholly and entirely vacated and shall no longer be or constitute any part of the streets of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and the ownership thereof shall convert to the owners of the adjacent real estate, one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) upon each side thereof.

Section 3. All of the sections or parts of sections in conflict herewith are repealed.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
