## ORDINANCE NO. 1555

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY/CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, AMENDING SECTION 25-11 (q) AND 25-16, OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Section 25-11 (q) of the City Code is hereby amended to read:

"Section 25-11 (q). Electricity and Telephone.

- 1. The mobile home parks secondary electrical distribution system to mobile home lots shall be single phased 115/230 volts nominal. All electrical installations in mobile home parks shall be designed and constructed in accordance with the applicable provisions of the national electrical code (NFPA No. 70-1975 or later editions as adopted by the City of Lexington)."
- 2. All power and telephone line shall be underground and shall be in compliance with standards of the utility corporation involved.

Section 2. Section 25-16 of the City Code is hereby amended to read:
"Section 25-16. Existing Mobile Home Parks Authorized.

All mobile home parks within the zoning jurisdiction of the City of Lexington, which were in existence and operation on May 6, 1971, shall be authorized to be non-conforming to subsections a, b, e, f, g, h, i, j, k, l, and q (2), of Section 25-11 of the Lexington City Code so long as they do not present health or safety hazards as prohibited by these regulations and so long as they are not operated in a manner to expand or make worse any of the non-conforming provisions."

Section 3. All of the sections or parts of sections in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
