ORDINANCE NO. 1652

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-10 AND 2-11 OF THE CITY CODE OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA; TO PROVIDE AN AMOUNT FOR BONDS OF EMPLOYEES AND TO PROVIDE A TIME FOR PAYMENT OF SALARY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 2-10 AND 2-11 AND ALL OTHER SECTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2-10 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-10. Salaries.

All elective and appointive officers of the City shall receive annual salaries as provided by statutes, special ordinances or resolutions. The salary of the city attorney, city manager, and city clerk-treasurer shall by paid bi-weekly. All other appointive and elective officers shall be paid quarterly.

Beginning June 1, 1974, the annual salary of the Council shall be One Thousand Dollars for the president and Six Hundred Fifty Dollars for each of the other councilmen. The present salary of Six Hundred Dollars for the president and Four Hundred Dollars for each of the other councilmen shall continue until that date.

Section 2. Section 2-11 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-11. Bonds.

The following city officers and employees shall be required to give bond in the amount shown after the name of each office. The city shall pay the premiums of the bonds so required.

City manager
City clerk-treasurer
Police magistrate
All other employees shall be covered by a blanket bond or by an
individual bond in an amount not less than \$5,000.00, in the
discretion of the city manager

Section 3. That original Section 2-10 and 2-11 of the Lexington City Code are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
