

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 21-42 AND 21-43 OF THE CODE; TO PROVIDE A SALARY RANGE SCHEDULE AND CLASSIFICATION OF POSITIONS; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTIONS 21-42 AND 21-43 AND ALL OTHER SECTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: TO PROVIDE FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 21-42 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 21-42. Salary range schedule by pay grade.

The following salary range schedule to pay grades shall be used to determine the salary range for all city employees who are under the classified service, as follows:



The City Manager will prepare a job specification for each classified position and will file such with the clerk-treasurer.


Section 3. That original Sections 21-42 and 21-43 and all other sections in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
