ORDINANCE NO. 1663

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NOS. 232 AND 233 PROVIDING FOR GRADING, CONCRETE PAVING, CURB AND GUTTER, AND DRAINAGE THEREIN; AND ORDERING THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City of Lexington, Improvement Districts to be known as "Improvement District No. 232" and "Improvement District No. 233."

Section 2. The Improvement Districts shall consist of the following streets or portions of streets in the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

A. Improvement District No. 232

High Street from Adams Street to Washington Street. The property abutting thereon to be included in the district, being described as follows: The South One-Half (S_2) of Blocks One (1), Two (2), and Three (3) and the North One-Half (N_2) of Blocks Four (4), Five (5) and Six (6) of James Ervin's First Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska; and the South One-Half (S_2) of Blocks Two (2) and Three (3) and the North One-Half (N_2) of Blocks Four (4) and Five (5) of Stuckey and Little's Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

B. Improvement District No. 233

Taylor Street from Walnut Street to High Street. The property abutting thereon to be included in the district, being described as follows: Lots Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), and Nine (9) of Block Two (2), and Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), and Eighteen (18) of Block Three (3), all in James Ervin's First Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 3. There shall be constructed and provided on the above described streets, grading, paving and drainage which shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates to be hereinafter adopted.

Section 4. The streets provided in the above section will abut on curb and gutter where it exists; and will include curb and gutter where curb and gutter has not already been provided. Section 5. That the cost of such grading, paving and drainage except street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of the streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefit received, to be determined by the City Council as the law provides.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
