ORDINANCE NO. 1690

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE CONVEYANCE OF REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THE CITY AND THE MANNER AND TERMS OF SALE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the real estate described as:

Lots Eight (8) and Nine (9), in Block One (1), Ervin's Subdivision of the North Half ($N_{\frac{1}{2}}$) of the West Half ($N_{\frac{1}{2}}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($N_{\frac{1}{2}}$) of Section Eight (8), Township Nine (9) North, Range Twenty-One (21) West of the 6th P. M., Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska,

is owned by the City of Lexington, and is in excess of the needs of the City of Lexington, being the site of an abandoned well.
