

ORDINANCE NO. 1721

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-2 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO AMEND THE TIME OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 2-2 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

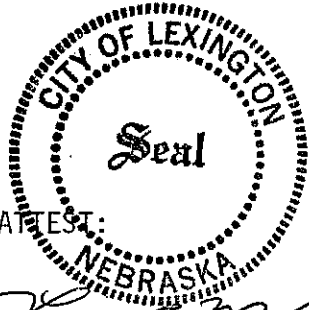
Section 1. That Section 2-2 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2-2. Meeting of City Council. Regular meetings of the City Council shall be held at the City offices at 7 o'clock P. M., on the second and fourth Tuesdays of each month. Special meetings shall be held as may be provided by the statutes of the State. The place and time of meetings may be changed by the majority of the Council. A notice of such change of meetings shall be published in a legal newspaper at least one (1) week before such meeting.

Section 2. That original Section 2-2 of the Lexington City Code and all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict therewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect as provided by law.
