ORDINANCE NO. 1748

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 28-23 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO REQUIRE A SPECIAL USE PERMIT FOR STORAGE OF HAZARDOUS MATERIALS; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 28-¹³38; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 28-23 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:
