

ORDINANCE NO. 1778

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 24-2, TO PROVIDE FOR TEMPORARY USE OF SIDEWALKS FOR DISPLAY OF MERCHANDISE; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 24-2 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 24-2 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 24-2. Display of merchandise on streets and sidewalks prohibited

No vehicles, machinery, or other articles of merchandise shall be displayed for sale on the streets or sidewalks of the City, except as follows:

(a) The City Manager may permit the use of sidewalks to all merchants for display of merchandise.

(b) The City Manager may permit a temporary use of streets and sidewalks to civic groups and non-profit organizations, and other civic and non-profit enterprises.

Section 2. The original Section 24-2 and all other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
