ORDINANCE NO. 1792

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 22-2, 22-3, AND 22-6 IN THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE, ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT FOR A REFUSE AND GARBAGE COLLECTION FRANCHISE; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTIONS 22-2, 22-3 AND 22-6, TOGETHER WITH ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 22-2 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 22-2. Refuse and Garbage Disposal.

The owners or occupants of all residential, commercial or industrial properties within the City of Lexington shall be responsible for the collection and disposal of refuse and garbage, either by contracting with a refuse and garbage collection enterprise or by personally collecting, conveying and disposing of such refuse.

Section 2. That Section 22-3 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 33-2. License for Refuse and Garbage Collection Service.

No person or business entity shall conduct a refuse or garbage collection service for hire within the City of Lexington without first having obtained a license for that purpose issued by the City Clerk. Such license shall be issued only to such persons or entities complying with standards established by the City Manager. Such license shall be issued for one (1) calendar year, and can be revoked at any time by the City Manager for non-compliance with standards established.

Section 3. That Section 22-6 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 22-6. Landfill Use Charges.

The City Council shall establish by resolution a schedule of charges and fees for the use of the sanitary landfill. Such schedule of fees and charges may take into consideration expenditures of City tax money in determining fees and charges for refuse and garbage generated inside or outside of the corporate City limits.

Section 4. That original Sections 22-2, 22-3 and 22-6, together with all other ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
