## ORDINANCE NO. 1812

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 19-13 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO PROVIDE FOR CITY COUNCIL OPTION IN ALLOWING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON CITY PROPERTY; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 19-13 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREIN; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 19-13 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 19-13. Intoxicating Liquors . . . Public Consumption

It shall be unlawful for any person to consume alcoholic liquors within the City in the public streets, alleys, roads, or highways or upon property owned by the state or any governmental subdivision thereof, unless authorized by the governing body having jurisdiction over such properties, or inside vehicles while upon the public streets, alleys, roads, or highways, in theaters, dance halls, or in any other place open to the public, and no person shall drink any alcoholic liquors other than beer upon any premises within which beer is sold at retail; provided, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to prohibit persons purchasing beer upon premises within which beer is lawfully sold for consumption on the premises, from drinking such beer on such premises.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effective from and after its final passage and publication as required by law.
