Ordinance No. 1917

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SCHEDULE OF RATES FOR THE SALE OF NATURAL GAS IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1809; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The rates charged by K N Enery, Inc. (KN) for natural gas supplied to customers in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as "City," unless otherwise approved by the Mayor and City Council and as appropriately adjusted by operation of the gas cost adjustment ordinance, shall not exceed the following, effective October 1, 1990:

First 10 Ccf per month, \$8.000000*
Next 40 Ccf per month, \$0.458451 Per Ccf
Next 450 Ccf per month, \$0.400924 Per Ccf
All Additional per month, \$0.382112 Per Ccf

*Minimum Monthly Charge: Shall be an amount equal to the charge for the first 10 Ccf as adjusted as provided for by the City's gas supply cost adjustment ordinance.

Delayed Payment Charge: 5% on the first \$20.00 of bill, plus 2% on excess.


Bills will be rendered at monthly intervals.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 1809, governing natural gas rates and all other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed. Provided, this ordinance shall be construed so as to affect any rights, liabilities, or causes of action, either criminal or civil, now existing or that may exist or accrue before this ordinance takes effect, or actions pending at the time when this ordinance takes effect.


Section 3. This ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
