ORDINANCE NO. 1931

AN ORDINANCE CREATING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 91-3, PROVIDING FOR GRADING, CONCRETE PAVING, CURB AND GUTTER, AND DRAINAGE THEREIN, AND ORDERING THE ORDINANCE PUBLISHED IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. There is hereby created within the City of Lexington, an Improvement District to be known as "Improvement District No. 91-3".

Section 2. The Improvement District shall consist of the following real estate in the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

Lots Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10), Eleven (11), and Twelve (12) Greater Lexington Addition to the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska.

Section 3. There shall be constructed and provided on the above described real estate, grading, paving and drainage along South Jefferson Street from its intersection with Commerce Road to a point Four Hundred Feet (400') south of said intersection with Commerce Road, all in Greater Lexington Addition, which shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications, and estimates to be hereinafter adopted.

Section 4. The streets provided in the above section will abut on curb and gutter where it exists, and may include curb and gutter where curb and gutter has not already been provided.

Section 5. That the cost of such grading, paving and drainage including street and alley intersections, shall be assessed against lots and tracts of land abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of the streets, specifically benefited thereby, in proportion to the benefit received, to be determined by the City Council as the law provides.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
