ORDINANCE NO 1936

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONEY OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING LIABILITIES, EXPENSES, AND FOR NECESSARY IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING THE 1ST DAY OF AUGUST, 1991, AND ENDING THE 31ST DAY OF JULY, 1992; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, after public hearing on the issue, has authorized an increase of five percent (5%) of anticipated receipts from property tax for fiscal year 1991-92.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.

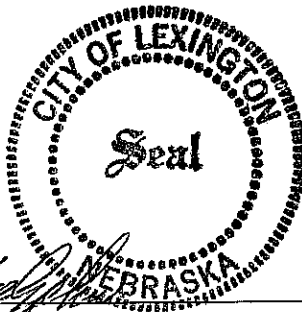
Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of money to be raised by a general levy of taxes upon all property within the City of Lexington, Nebraska, and of money now on hand and other revenue available for improvements and expenses of said City, for the Fiscal Year 1991-92, the following sum of money to wit:
