## ORDINANCE NO. 2037

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 3-6 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO PROVIDE FOR SALE OF LIQUOR ON NEW YEARS EVE WHEN THE SAME FALLS ON SUNDAY; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 3-6, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

Section 1: That Section 3-6 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

## Sec. 3-6 Hours of Sale Generally.

- (a) No alcoholic liquors shall be sold at retail or dispensed on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas, between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 1:00 A.M. the day following, provided, that beer and wine may be sold at retail for off-premises consumption only on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday, or on Thanksgiving Day or Christmas, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 1:00 A.M. the day following, and provided further, that when December 31 shall fall on a Sunday, alcoholic liquor may be sold or dispensed for on or off-premises consumption between 12:00 noon and 1:00 A.M. the day following.
  - (b) No alcoholic liquors, including beer, shall be sold at retail or dispensed on secular days between 1:00 A.M. and 6:00 A.M.
  - (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit licensed premises from being open for other business on days and hours during which the sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor is prohibited by this section.

Section 2. That original § 3-6 together with all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
