

ORDINANCE NO. 2046

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, PROVIDING FOR ONE-WAY TRAVEL ON EAST 12TH STREET BETWEEN WASHINGTON STREET AND GRANT STREET; TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, as follows:

Section 1. Section 16-21.1 One-Way Traffic.

- A. The Lexington City Council may, by Resolution, provide for one-way travel in any street or alley located in the municipality and shall provide for appropriate signs and markings when said streets have been so designated by Resolution.
- B. That East 12th Street from Washington Street to Grant Street shall be designated for one-way traffic, from West to East, and shall be marked with appropriate signs.

Section 2. That all Ordinances or sections of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect August 1, 1996.
