## ORDINANCE NO. 2082

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 5-5 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO REMOVE POULTRY, CHICKENS, TURKEYS, DUCKS, GEESE AND OTHER FOWL FROM RESIDENTIAL AREAS OF THE CITY; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 5-5 AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 5-5 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 5-5 Keeping Animals and Beehives in Proximity to Dwellings.

It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person, either by himself, his agents, servants or employees, to have under such person's control, care or custody, any beehive, livestock animal, or fowl, including but not limited to horses, cattle, hogs, sheep, goats, poultry, chickens, turkeys, ducks, geese, or other like fowl, at any place within the City which is within six hundred feet (600') of any dwelling house in the City. This Section shall not apply to fowl kept for display in a public park.

Section 2. That original Section 5-5, together with all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
