

ORDINANCE NO. 2286

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 19-3 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE; TO AMEND THE PERMISSABLE DATES FOR SALE OF FIREWORKS; TO REPEAL ORIGINAL SECTION 19-3, AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** That Section 19-3 of the Lexington City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 19-3 Fireworks--Possession and Sale.

It shall be unlawful for any person to have possession of, for sale or for any other purpose, to offer for sale, or to use, within the City, any fireworks of any kind, except as defined as "Consumer fireworks" by Section 28-1241(6), and except as are defined as "Display fireworks" by Section 28-1241 (7), of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska. Such fireworks shall be used, or sold at retail, only on those dates of each year when sale of such fireworks is permitted by Section 28-1249 of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska and by Regulation of the State Fire Marshall.

**Section 2.** That original Section 19-3, together with all ordinances or sections of ordinances in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

**Section 3.** That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and take effect as provided by law.
