

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, there has been signed by the City of Lexington on the 24th day of March 1955, and by the State on the 13th day of April 1955, an agreement providing for the construction of a Federal Aid Secondary Road beginning on Adams Street (Highway No. 21) between Pacific Avenue and 20th Streets.

WHEREAS, in the above agreement, the City has pledged sufficient funds to finance its share of the cost of the construction of this project identified as US-429(4) and Paving and Improvement District No. 13.

WHEREAS, the above mentioned agreement provided that the City and the State will equally and jointly pay the non-Federal costs of the grading and paving items and the City by itself will pay the non-Federal costs of all other items, and

WHEREAS, The State and the City received bids for the construction of this project on May 24, 1956, at which time 5 bids were received for the construction of the proposed work, and

WHEREAS, the following contractor has been selected as the low bidder to whom a contract should be awarded:

Francis R. Orshek, Inc. - grading, pavement & culverts - \$189,210.65


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above facts, the City Council of the City of Lexington, by this resolution, takes the following official action:

1. The Council hereby concurs in the selection of the above mentioned contractor to whom a contract should be awarded.
2. The Council does not desire to perform any of the work with its own forces in lieu of performing the work by the contract method.
3. The Council hereby authorized the Mayor and the City Clerk of Lexington to sign the construction contract on behalf of said City.
