

RESOLUTION OF ELECTION CANVASS

A Resolution finding and determining the results of the Special Election held in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, on June 28, 1955, for submission to the qualified votes of said city the proposition authorizing the City Council of said City to sell to the Dawson County Public Power District, a public corporation of Lexington, Nebraska, approximately forty-two and one-half ( $42\frac{1}{2}$ ) miles of rural electric distribution lines belonging to the City of Lexington, generally adjacent to the City of Lexington, (not including any of the urban system) for the sum of Thirty-six Thousand One Hundred Twenty-five (\$36,125.00) Dollars, as provided in Section 70-504, Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, Reissue of 1950.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, sitting as a Board of Canvassers, to Canvass the returns of the Special Election held in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, on June 28, 1955, on the following proposition, to-wit:

"Shall the President of the Council and the Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, sell to the Dawson County Public Power District, a public corporation of Lexington, Nebraska, approximately forty-two and one-half ( $42\frac{1}{2}$ ) miles of rural electric distribution lines belonging to the City of Lexington, generally adjacent to the City of Lexington, (not including any of the urban system) for the sum of Thirty-six Thousand One Hundred Twenty-five (\$36,125.00) Dollars, as provided in Section 70-504, Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, Reissue of 1950."

Section 1. We find and determine that said Special Election was in all respects regular and that the following vote was cast at said election For and Against said proposition, Viz;

Section 2. We further find that the Affirmative of said proposition having received a majority of more than fifty per cent of the votes cast, and an actual majority of more than 78 per cent, said proposition is carried, and it is hereby so declared.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the President of the Council and the Council of said City of Lexington, Nebraska, that we have fully canvassed the results of the Special Election held in said City on June 28, 1955, upon the proposition above set forth, and we hereby find, declare and certify that said returns of election, as made by the several election boards are correct, and that the affirmative of said proposition carried by a majority of 123 votes, and that the total votes cast for the Affirmative of said proposition was more than 78 per cent of the votes cast at said election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of said City proceed with the sale of the Rural Electric Distribution lines as authorized by said election and as provided by the contracts of the City with the Dawson County Public Power District, at the earliest practicable date.
