

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The City of Lexington desires to give by deed a plot of real estate to the State of Nebraska for use as an armory site by the Military Department of the Nebraska National Guard only, and

WHEREAS, the plot to be conveyed is a strip of land two hundred (200) feet wide extending from Washington Street to Bridge Street through Arbor Park, the north boundary of which is a line twenty (20) feet south and parallel with the south side of the Dawson County Public Power District's storage building, and

WHEREAS, certain technical matters exist that prevents an immediate transfer of the above described plot.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:



That as soon/as the technical objections have been removed, the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, shall convey to the State of Nebraska for use as an armory site by the Military Department of the Nebraska National Guard, only, a plot of land two hundred (200) feet wide extending from Washington Street to Bridge Street through Arbor Park, Lexington, Nebraska, the north boundary of which is a line twenty (20) feet south and parallel with the south side of the Dawson County Public Power District's storage building.

That the above plot of land shall be legally described as soon as the City Engineer shall cause it to be surveyed or surveyed and platted.
