

RESOLUTION NO. 878

A Resolution authorizing the filing of an application with the Public Health Service, United States of America, for a Grant under the Water Pollution Control Act, (33 U.S.C. 446 et seq.)

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Water Pollution Control Act, (33 U.S.C. 446 et Seq.), the United States of America has authorized the making of Grants to authorized applicants to aid in the construction of specific public projects:

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA.

1. That J. Roy Deeter be and he is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, with the Public Health Service, United States Government, for a grant to aid in the construction of a SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT ADDITION.


2. That J. Roy Deeter, Vice-President of the Council be and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the United States Public Health Service may reasonably request in connection with the application which is herein authorized to be filed, and sign all necessary documents.
