

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington has constructed a Drainage Ditch across the County Road, running East and West between Sec. 3, Twp.9, Rge.21 and Sec.10, Twp.9, Rge.21, and whereas the Bridge over the Ditch is in disrepair, and needs to be completely reconstructed, and whereas the County of Dawson is willing to construct said bridge and perpetually maintain, and whereas the City of Lexington is willing to pay the County of Dawson the sum of \$4,000 to construct and maintain said bridge, \$2,000 of said sum being payable immediately, and the balance of \$2,000 on or before August 1, 1964.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE DAWSON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, that the County of Dawson assume the obligation to construct and perpetually maintain the bridge over the drainage ditch constructed by the City of Lexington, said drainage ditch crossing the County Road, running East and West between Sec.3, Twp.9, Rge.21 and Sec.10, Twp.9, Rge.21, upon the condition that the City of Lexington pay the County of Dawson \$4,000, \$2,000 being payable immediately, and the balance of \$2,000 on or before August 1, 1964.

NOW on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1962, Commissioner Marshall moved the adoption of said resolution, and Commissioner Dickerson seconded the same. Commissioners Marshall, Dickerson and Bell, voted for the adoption of said resolution,
