WHEREAS, Route 283 has been changed to Bridge Street beginning at Ash Street and continuing North to 5th Street and Jackson Street, and,


WHEREAS, The City proposes the paving of Bridge Street from Ash Street to Maple Street under the plans and specifications of Federal Aid Project U-252-13, and,

WHEREAS, the Federal Government and State Government contemplate participating in the payment of the cost of the said pavement and it is beneficial for property owners to know in advance and with certainty what the improvement and paving costs will be assessed against them in the event an improvement district is created on the said Bridge Street between Ash Street and Maple Street under the said Federal Aid Project U-252-13,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA,


That in regard to Bridge Street in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, from Ash Street to Maple Street the table for assessments cost which was passed on the 24th day of November, 1953, in which the cost of the pavement is shown on the Resolution for various widths of pavement as having benefited adjoining property owners at various assessments costs according to widths, be changed for this one district so that the cost of the said pavement under the said project be assessed against the property which is included in the district at a front footage cost of \$4.00 per front foot.
