

RESOLUTION OF ELECTION CANVASS

A Resolution finding and determining the results of Special Election held in the City of Lexington, Nebraska, February 21, 1967, for submission to the qualified voters of said City the proposition of authorizing the City of Lexington to issue its negotiable bonds for such amount as may be necessary to pay for the right-of-way for a viaduct and property damages as may be necessary and the levy of a tax annually sufficient in rate and amount to pay said bonds and interest therefor.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, sitting as a Board of canvassers, to canvass the returns of the Special Election held in the City of Lexington, Nebraska on February 21, 1967, on the following proposition, to-wit:

"Shall the City of Lexington issue its negotiable bonds for such amount as may be necessary to pay for the right-of-way for a viaduct commencing North of the intersection of Bridge Street and Maple Street and extending North and Northeasterly crossing over the Railroad tracks and U. S. Highway Number 30 to and ending at the intersection of Jackson and 5th Streets, and damages resulting from the construction thereof, and

"Shall the City of Lexington levy annually a tax on all taxable property in the City except intangible property sufficient in rate and amount to pay said bonds and interest thereon as the same severally become due?"

Section 1. We find and determine that said Special Election was in all respects regular and that the following vote was cast at said election For and Against said proposition, viz:

Section 2. We further find that the Affirmative of said proposition having received a majority of more than sixty per cent of the votes cast, and an actual majority of more than 83.86 per cent, said proposition is carried, and it is hereby so declared.


