

R E S O L U T I O N

A RESOLUTION ASSESSING A POLL TAX FOR THE YEAR 1965 ON MALE INHABITANTS OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON WHO ARE BETWEEN THE AGES OF 21 AND 50.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

That pursuant to authority granted to cities of the first class by Section 16-710, reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, there is hereby levied on every male inhabitant of the City of Lexington, who is between the ages of 21 and 50 years, except those individuals exempt by law, a poll tax for the year 1965 in the amount of \$3.00 per individual, said poll tax to be placed on the tax lists to be collected in the same manner as set forth in the above referred to Nebraska Statutes.

IT IS FURTHER DIRECTED, that a certified copy of this Resolution be delivered by the City Clerk to the County Clerk of County Assessor of Dawson County, Nebraska.
