
A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND PROJECT ON A 50% FEDERAL AND 50% LOCAL BASIS ON IMPROVEMENTS AT OAK PARK, IN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.

WHEREAS, The Federal Aid Administrator III has approved the land and water conservation fund project for Oak Park on a 50% Federal and 50% local basis, and,


WHEREAS, The City Council of Lexington, Nebraska, desires to proceed with the project on a 50-50 basis,
