

RESOLUTION NO. 1499

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING AND EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF SECTION 24-1 OF THE LEXINGTON CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.


WHEREAS, Section 24-1 of the City Code is in conflict with the rules and regulations of the United States Postal Department, and

WHEREAS, Section 24-1 prohibits the placing of any obstruction in the sidewalks in the City of Lexington, and


WHEREAS, the City Council has been made aware of the fact that many property owners are presently placing mail boxes in the sidewalks,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that the Council hereby directs the City Manager to enforce the provisions of Section 24-1 and to notify all property owners who are in violation of the Code to remove any obstructions within 90 days of receipt of written notice. The City Manager is further directed to formulate an alternative or alternatives to complete removal of obstructions and to notify property owners of any such alternatives.
