A RESOLUTION CREATING A CITIZENS COMMITTEE AND PROJECT DIRECTOR TO FORMULATE ALTERNATE PLANS FOR FLOOD CONTROL ALONG SPRING CREEK IN THE AREA OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA.


WHEREAS, a need exists to formulate a plan for flood control from Spring Creek in the area of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, to protect the citizens of Lexington and farmers along Spring Creek, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lexington, Dawson County, Nebraska, desires to create a citizens committee and appoint a project director to formulate alternate plans for flood control,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA, that the President of the City Council is hereby authorized to appoint a citizens committee consisting of 5 to 11 members and a project director to formulate alternate plans for flood control from Spring Creek in the Lexington area, with the following duties:

1. The committee will work with the project director to coordinate and develop plans for flood protection to area residents and farmers along Spring Creek in the Lexington area.
2. The committee and project director will formulate the necessary easements and construction requirements.
3. The committee and project director will present alternate flood control proposals to the County Board of Commissioners and the Lexington City Council for consideration.
