A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR RAIL PASSENGER SERVICE  
FOR THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, DAWSON COUNTY, NEBRASKA

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Lexington and Dawson County, Nebraska have no scheduled air line or passenger train service, and


WHEREAS, the citizens of Lexington and Dawson County are served only by interstate bus transportation, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Lexington, now enjoying the national distinction of winning an All American City award for 1973, are desirous of obtaining scheduled passenger train service to alleviate the scarcity of public transportation and to restore the pleasures and conveniences of travel by rail, and


WHEREAS, a non-profit corporation entitled Western Association of Railroad Passengers (WARP) has undertaken efforts to restore rail passenger service from the Mid-West to the West Coast via a route that would serve the citizens of the City of Lexington and the surrounding communities,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Lexington, Nebraska, that the Council expresses its strong support for the activities now being conducted by the Western Association of Railroad Passengers in its effort to effect the restoration of such east-west passenger train service as would serve the citizens of the City of Lexington and the surrounding communities.
