

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION supporting and urging the residents of the community to support the building of a new area hospital.

WHEREAS, the conclusion of all studies which have been made recently, indicates that the present hospital facility in Lexington, Nebraska, is old, out-of-date, unsafe and obsolete when compared to present-day minimum standards for space, efficiency, comfort, safety and mechanical system; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 1970, a majority of the people in eastern Dawson County and northern Gosper County voted to create an Area Hospital District encompassing approximately 756 square miles of the two counties; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Area Hospital District, after thorough evaluation, decided to present to a vote of the people the issuing of bonds to construct a new area hospital facility; and

WHEREAS, the decision to issue bonds for the construction of a new area hospital facility will be voted on by the people in the District on November 7, 1972; and


WHEREAS, the members of the Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, deem the construction of a new area hospital facility a project worthy of total community support as an important part of complete and comprehensive medical services for the residents of the Area Hospital District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA:


Section 1. The members of the City Council do hereby deem the construction of a new area hospital facility a project worthy of their total support and hereby extend that support.

Section 2. The members of the City Council further encourage and urge all business, industrial and financial leaders and all other residents of the community to support the construction of a new area hospital facility.
