

RESOLUTION NO. R1613


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA;

WHEREAS, The City Council finds and determines that the detour of Highway 30 through the City of Lexington creates a substantial risk to the citizens of the City and particularly to the school age children of the City of Lexington who must cross the detour route in order to attend school, and,

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this situation creates an immediate risk and action should be taken at this time in an effort to rectify the situation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that flashing red lights be placed at the intersections of 13th & Tyler and 13th & Harrison Streets and that the crossings be marked at 11th & Jackson, 12th & Jackson, 13th & Erie and 15th & Erie in an effort to prevent serious injury to the citizens of the City of Lexington, Nebraska.
