

RESOLUTION R1635

This resolution of the Lexington, Nebraska City Council, sets forth the intentions of this body to go on record urging the Interstate Commerce Commission and the Nebraska Public Service Commission to grant the application of the Greyhound Lines, Inc. for authority to operate direct motor bus service between Lincoln, Nebraska on the one hand, and, Grand Island and points beyond on the other, via Interstate Highway 80.


WHEREAS, it has been brought to our attention that Grayhound Lines, Inc. has applied to the Interstate Commerce Commission and the Nebraska Public Service Commission for authority to operate a motor bus service between Lincoln and Grand Island over Interstate Highways 80 and 281;

WHEREAS, The Lexington, Nebraska City Council believes this proposed service by Greyhound Lines, Inc. would be of benefit and serve public convenience and necessity;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this body go on record as urging the Interstate Commerce Commission and Nebraska Public Service Commission to grant the application of Greyhound Lines, Inc. to operate a motor bus service between Lincoln and Grand Island, Nebraska as aforesaid.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Lexington City Manager, or any person so designated by the City Manager, be and they are hereby authorized to appear at any hearing called by the Interstate Commerce Commission and Nebraska Public Service Commission in connection with this matter; and there to testify in support of the applicant, Greyhound Lines, Inc.
