

RESOLUTION 86-10

WHEREAS, the Business Improvement Act, Section 19-4015, ff,R.R.S. 1943 provides a means of improving and developing business areas of the City, and

WHEREAS, the Business Improvement Board consisting of property owners, residents, business operators, or users of space within such business area should be appointed to make recommendations to the City Council for improvement of the business area.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the business area considered for improvement shall be those areas within the City zoning jurisdiction currently zoned C-0, C-1, C-2, or C-3.

Section 2. That the original Business Improvement Board shall consist of seven (7) person, to serve a term of five (5) years each, except that the original Board shall be organized so that four (4) members serve a term of three (3) years and three (3) members serve a term of five (5) years. The following persons are hereby appointed to such Board: Randy Martin, Carlene Schmidt, Jim Kelly, Steve Moseley, James Doyle IV, Scott Latter, and Margharite Evans.
