

RESOLUTION NO. 86-15

WHEREAS, State statutes and the Lexington City Code give the City Council authority to authorize consumption of alcoholic liquor on City property.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That upon property owned by the City of Lexington, consumption of alcoholic liquors shall be authorized only in that portion of the City building which is designated as the fire hall or firemen's meeting room.

Section 2. That the foregoing authority shall be permitted only as a regular activity of the organization known as the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department.

Section 3. That the foregoing authority is subject to the express condition that all Lexington Fire Department by-laws, rules and regulations concerning consumption of alcoholic liquors by members shall be strictly enforced.

Section 4. That the foregoing authority may be terminated by the Lexington City Council at any time, without notice or hearing.
