

RESOLUTION NO. 88-4

WHEREAS, the Lexington City Council has authority, by resolution, to set electric rate charges; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a special rate for services which can be interrupted will affect savings for the City through reduction of demand charges;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, that a separate "interruptible" rate is hereby established for industrial service as follows:

The industrial user and the City Manager shall enter into a separate agreement outlining the terms and conditions for interruption of electrical service, which charge shall be \$6.00 per KW of demand and \$.021 per KWH from May 15th through September 15th, and a charge of \$.052 per KWH from September 16th through May 14th.
