

RESOLUTION NO. 88-14

WHEREAS, property tax relief is a vital issue in the future growth and development of the City of Lexington, and

WHEREAS, the city sales tax would replace a substantial portion of that property tax generally used for City purposes;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the mayor and council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, that at a special election to be held on January 17, 1989, the following issue shall be submitted to all qualified electors within the corporate limits of the City of Lexington, Nebraska:

Shall the governing body of the City of Lexington, Nebraska impose a sales and use tax at the rate of one percent (1%), upon the same transactions within such municipality on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, said tax to be used for property tax relief?

That a copy of this resolution shall be immediately submitted to the County Clerk of Dawson County, Nebraska, for inclusion on the ballot at said special election.
