

A RESOLUTION SETTING SEWER USE CHARGES FOR ALL USER CLASSIFICATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCE NO. 1482.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Lexington, Nebraska, has passed Ordinance No. 1482, effective April 1, 1977, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1482 provides formulas which are used to develop the sewer use charge for the sanitary sewer system, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1482 provides that the sewer use charges shall be set by Resolution by the City Council for all user classifications and be reviewed annually and revised periodically to reflect actual treatment plant costs, plant loadings, and sanitary sewer system costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Lexington, Nebraska that the following sewer use charge rates established for the flat rate residential and commercial customers shall be effective January 1, 1981 and will be reflected on the billings received in February. Industrial rate A will be effective January 1, 1981. All rates shall continue to be effective until revised:

Flat Rate Residential: \$7.19 per month per residence

A residential property occupied by two families shall pay an additional fifty percent or a total of \$10.79 per month.

Any property occupied by more than two families shall be serviced at the commercial rate.

Commercial: \$0.64 per 1,000 gallons

Minimum \$3.25 per month

Charges shall be based on average metered water usage for the preceding months of December, January and February.

Industrial (Rate A):

Flow: \$0.0629 per 1,000 gallons

BOD: \$0.0318 per pound

S.S.: \$0.0343 per pound
