

RESOLUTION NO. 1730

WHEREAS, Legislative Bill 220 has been introduced before the 88th Legislature, providing a defined benefit pension plan for volunteer fire department members; and

WHEREAS, the Lexington City Council favors the concept of providing additional benefits to the volunteer fire department members through a pension system, but not through a defined benefit pension system dictated by the State of Nebraska.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, hereby goes on record as being opposed to Legislative Bill 220 as presently before the 88th Session of the Nebraska State Legislature.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Lexington City Manager is directed and authorized to appear before the Nebraska State Legislature to oppose said bill and provide information in regard to the fiscal impact of said bill on the City of Lexington, Nebraska.


