

RESOLUTION NO. R1731

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington and the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department are authorized by law to agree with fire departments from other municipalities and fire districts to provide mutual aid assistance in fighting fires and in meeting emergencies, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the City of Lexington and the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department join with other communities in this area in the "South Central Mutual Aid Association."

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Lexington City Manager is hereby directed and authorized on behalf of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, to enter into a mutual aid agreement with the group of municipalities and rural fire protection districts comprising the South Central Mutual Aid Association.

Section 2. That the Lexington Volunteer Fire Department is hereby authorized to enter into the same agreement with municipalities and rural fire protection districts comprising the South Central Mutual Aid Association, and thereby use equipment belonging to the City of Lexington to provide fire and emergency service outside of the Lexington City limits and within the terms of said mutual aid agreement.
