

RESOLUTION NO. 90-01

WHEREAS, air travel in the United States has grown to such proportions that major terminals and hubs are experiencing gridlock, and

WHEREAS, the FAA and other Federal agencies are exploring a variety of solutions to this national problem, and

WHEREAS, there has surfaced the concept of a series of wayports to help ease much of the problem. That wayports would be located away from major urban congestion and would be used almost exclusively for transferring national and international travelers, and

WHEREAS, Nebraska is an ideal location for one of the proposed wayports because of our central location, our relatively inexpensive land, our open spaces, and our high percentage of clear days, and


WHEREAS, within the State of Nebraska the South Central area offers all of the support services needed for a major installation, and yet offers all of the qualities sought by the advocates of the wayport concept,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Lexington City Council that we united with the City Councils and the Boards of Supervisors of cities and counties in South Central Nebraska in urging Nebraska Governor Orr, her administration, Senators Exon and Kerrey, and the members of the House of Representatives, Virginia Smith, Doug Bereuter and Peter Hoagland to mount a coordinate campaign to secure the selection of Nebraska as the site of one of the wayports.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the political and civic leadership of the South Central Nebraska area place the highest priority on the ultimate selection of this area as the best site within Nebraska for the location of the wayport.


