

Resolution No. 90-11

WHEREAS, there has been one or more recent instances of racist activities in Lexington, Nebraska, where a person was assaulted solely on the basis of his race; and

WHEREAS, the members of the City Council wish to express their disapproval and condemnation of such action.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that all persons of whatever race, creed, color, religion or national origin are welcome within the City of Lexington, and surrounding area.

FURTHER RESOLVED that any action on the part of any citizen of Lexington, Nebraska, to deprive citizens of any race, creed, color, religion or national origin of the full rights and privileges of any other citizen, is hereby condemned.
