

RESOLUTION NO. 92- 9

Whereas, the interlocal agency committee responsible for operation of the sanitary landfill at Lexington, Nebraska has requested a cessation of delivery of grass clippings and yard waste at the landfill site; and

Whereas, the useful life of the landfill will be greatly extended if City residents look to alternate means of disposal or composting of grass clippings and yard waste;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Lexington sanitary landfill and any licensed garbage and refuse collection services are hereby authorized and directed to discontinue collection and taking of grass clippings or other vegetative waste material removed from lawns or gardens for delivery to the landfill;

2. That the City is directed to continue operation of a composting site for deposit of such materials;

3. That this Resolution shall take effect July 1, 1992.
