

RESOLUTION NO. 96-30

WHEREAS, LB 1085 (Laws 1996), as amended by LB 693 (Laws 1996), authorizes the Governing Body to set a final property tax levy at a different amount than the preliminary levy certified to the Governing body by the County Clerk;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska has conducted a public hearing as prescribed by law and heard and considered comments concerning the propriety of the preliminary levy and the need to establish a different levy;

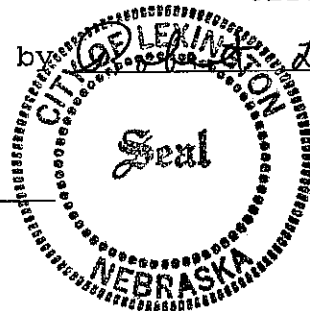
WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska, hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the Municipality that a levy set at a different amount than that of the preliminary levy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON, NEBRASKA, that the final levy of the Municipality for the fiscal year 1996-1997 is set at 0.11317 per one hundred dollars of actual valuation.
