

RESOLUTION NO. 98-06

WHEREAS, a grade separation study has been completed, determining that public safety will be improved by construction of an additional overpass over the Union Pacific Railroad tracks within the City; and,


WHEREAS, the Lexington City Council agrees with the study recommendation that an overpass be located at the Adams Street crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the mayor and council of the City of Lexington, Nebraska as follows:


1. That the grade separation study is hereby approved, including the recommendation for construction of an overpass at the Adams Street intersection with the Union Pacific Railroad;
2. That the Union Pacific Railroad Company and the State of Nebraska Department of Roads is hereby notified of such finding, and is requested to determine the necessity for construction of such overpass and determine the priority for funding of such construction
